

BMA workshops – always up to date



*Centrifugal seminar in
Braunschweig*

Last year, BMA again organised several user seminars. They all concentrated on the BMA centrifugal programme. One of these seminars was held in Braunschweig, and the other two in the USA.

One of the central issues of these events was obviously the new continuous K3300 centrifugal (see separate report about its main features in this issue of BMA Information). Since it has become more difficult to provide spare parts for the older centrifugal drives because of rapid developments in the electronics sector, much attention was also directed at the conversion of the control and drive systems of batch centrifugals.

During a tour of the company, the participants attending the seminar in Braunschweig were given an impression of the capabilities of BMA's workshop. They were particularly impressed by the large share of in-house production.

The two seminars in the United States were organised for the beet sugar factories in Fargo and North Dakota, and the cane processing factories and refineries in Clewiston, Florida. In total, more than 70 guests took great interest in the three seminars. As in previous years, when extraction plants, pulp presses and crystallisation were the central topics, the participants again expressed their interest in a continuation of the BMA seminar programme.
