Second-hand extraction for Kayseri Şeker, Turkey

For the extension of the main process in the Kayseri Şeker sugar factory, a second-hand extraction tower with a nominal capacity of 8,000 t/d was to be installed. Such an extraction tower had already been disassembled at the Aarberg sugar factory, Switzerland in January 2010, and loaded and shipped to Turkey.

BMA received an order for supervision of the assembly of this major sugar production plant, which started in April 2010. It was thanks to, among other things, the assignment of qualified chief erectors and a very precise detailed planning that the erection of the extraction tower could be performed at such a high level of quality. Already at the beginning of July, the plant was ready for operation and handed over to the customer. This was followed by installation of an additional countercurrent cossette mixer including ancillary aggregates upstream of the extraction tower for a beet slice rate of 10,000 t/d.
