2010 was a very busy and successful year for the BMA Group in China. Our team was active throughout the country.

As reported in the last BMA Information, the first VKT plant in China was commissioned in 2009 – the first continuous system for A-product in the Luyuan sugar factory in Northwest China's Xinjiang Province. The startup was a full success during the first campaign already. Further improvements were implemented for the 2010/2011 campaign: the factory changed the heating vapour from 3rd to 4th effect for the VKT – this has resulted in savings of more than CNY 3m per campaign in energy costs. By the end of 2010, the plant had been highly acclaimed by the China Sugar Association as a showcase project for energy saving and sugar process development.

With the installation of the third and fourth sugar drying and cooling plants installed at Chinese customers, BMA has now supplied all drying and cooling plants for China's refineries with a capacity of more than 1,000 t/d!

Our customer Xiwang Group in Shandong Province operates a combined drum dryer with integrated cooling system for its unique crystalline fructose production line. Another sugar dryer with fluidised-bed cooler was installed in late 2010 at East Asia Sugar Group's second refinery in the South Chinese Guangxi Province. East Asia opted for BMA's proven drum dryer technology with a separate fluidised-bed cooler to consistently and reliably achieve the required specifications in the warm and humid climate of South China.
