Robotics for cheese treatment

Robot technology at the IPA 2010 exhibition in Paris

In October 2010, the Amalgamated Sugar Company placed an order with BMA for a new sugar drying and cooling plant for their factory in Twin

Sugar drying and cooling plant for Twin Falls,

drying and cooling plant for their factory in Twin Falls, Idaho. The plant is designed for a maximum throughput of 50 t/h. It consists of a drum dryer and a downstream horizontal fluidised-bed cooler. For optimum energy utilisation, the dryer operates not only on hot drying air; it also uses the heated air from the cooler, which enters the dryer countercurrent to the sugar. The cooler is equipped with water-carrying cooling pipes positioned directly in the fluidised bed so that excellent cooling rates are achieved despite the very compact cooler design. The central exhaust-air filter was also included in the scope of supply.

The delivery period was relatively short: the equipment, which had completely been manufactured in BMA's workshop in Germany, arrived in Twin Falls in April /May 2011.
