In many countries, centrifugals are installations that require inspection and as such they must be checked at regular intervals. Regardless of any legal requirements, we as a centrifugal manufacturer advise our customers to have their centrifugal baskets inspected regularly by certified technical staff. Inspections focus on the openings, the weld seams and the basket hubs.



Benefits

- Inspections can be performed with the basket installed, achieving time savings of 50 % and more
- Considerably less disassembly work
- Compliance with legal requirements
- Greater operational reliability

Inspection procedure:

- Prior to inspection, the backing and cover screens are removed
- The inspection is performed by certified technical staff, in compliance with DIN EN ISO 9713
- Inspection time required per basket:
G and B series: approx. 5 hours,
E series: approx. 8 hours
- After the inspection, BMA issues a certificate stating the condition of the basket
